

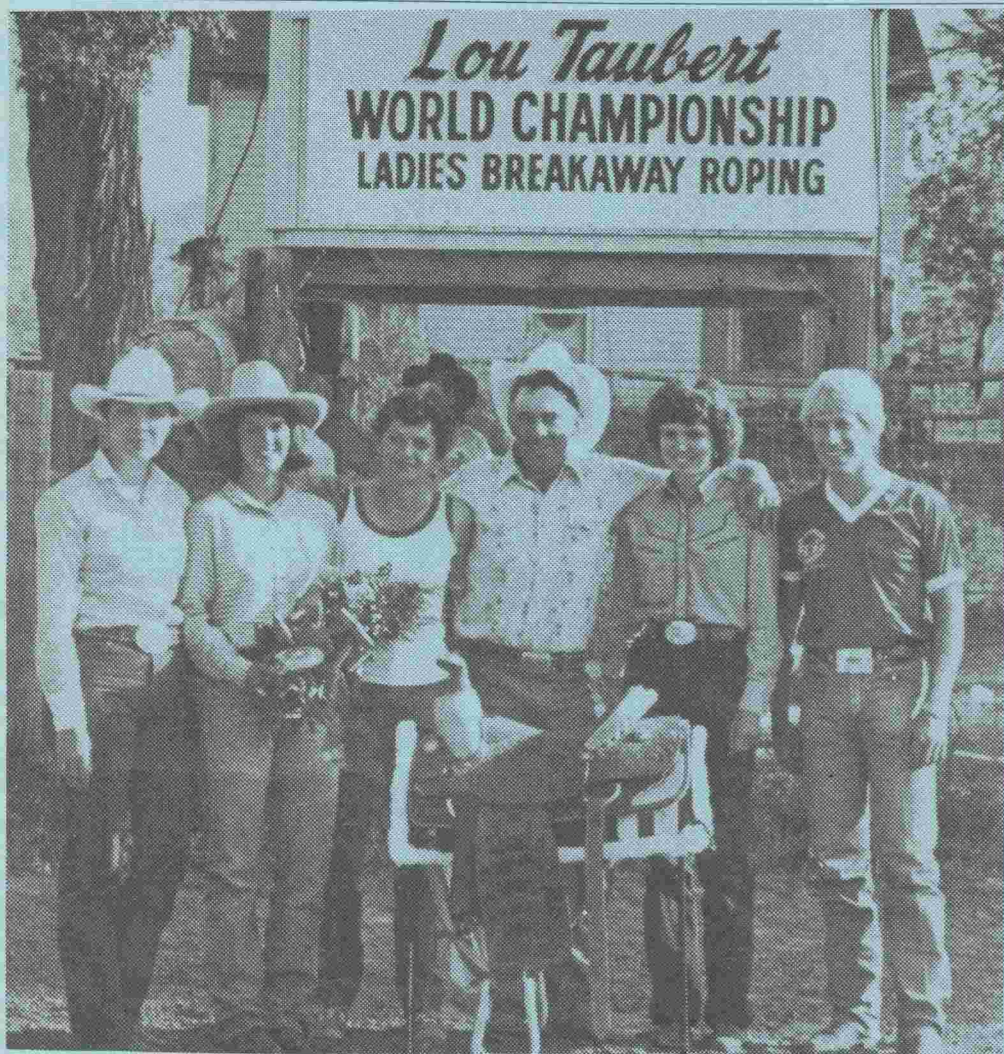

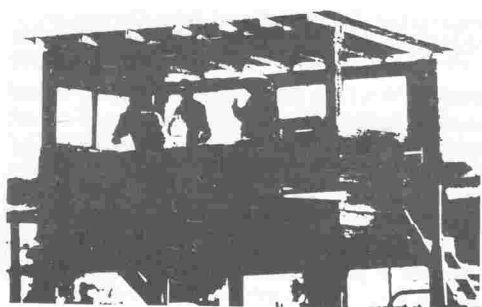

Breakaway Roping

Mary Hill of Hill Photo is fulfilling a long-desired goal, that of putting on a breakaway roping in her home town of Geyser, Mont. Scheduled for Sunday, Aug. 15, the all-girl event will feature an open breakaway roping sanctioned by the World Championship Breakaway Roping Association, a novice horse breakaway roping, a novice roper breakaway roping, an MBRA approved barrel race, and a novice barrel race.

The open breakaway roping will begin at 1 p.m. on Sunday with a calcutta preceding it at noon. The open breakaway roping will feature \$400 in added money, aided by a generous contribution by Coors beer, with \$50 fees and a \$5 stock charge. This will entitle the roper to two head with the top 10 getting a third calf.

The novice horse breakaway roping is for horses which have won less than \$100. This event has \$25 fees, to be jackpotted, and a \$5 stock charge. Each roper will get two runs.

The novice roper event is specifically for those ropers who have won less than \$100. Each roper will get two head with \$15 fees jackpotted and a \$5 stock charge.

The MBRA barrel race, with one run, has \$50 added and \$25 fees. The novice barrel race is a jackpot with \$15 fees.

Mary reports that prizes will be awarded to the top four in the open breakaway roping, and the winners in each of the other events.

Entries and fees will be accepted by mail only until Monday, Aug. 9. Post entries will be charged \$20. Mail entries and money to Hill Photo, Box 108, Geyser, Mont. 59447.

NRA/MRA Secretary Jann Johnson reports that she spends a considerable amount of time on the telephone giving rodeo secretaries card numbers of cowboys who have entered rodeos. She says that far too many of the card numbers asked for are cowboys who have competed in rodeos all season, and there is no reason for them not giving their card number. If someone else is entering you, she says, be sure and give them the card number, so it doesn't take up her time looking them up. Her time is really YOUR time, since she works for the association, and contestants are asked to please cooperate.

John Larick Hired As MSU Rodeo Coach

BOZEMAN — John A. Larick, a native of Kilgore, Idaho, has been named rodeo coach at Montana State University, according to Men's Athletic Director Tom Parac.

The 36-year-old Larick comes to MSU from Hartnell College in Salinas, Calif. where he has spent the last 11 years as the two-year school's rodeo advisor and coach. He fills the permanent position that was filled temporarily last season by Jim Jacobsen.

"John is a great teacher of rodeo skills and that has been the basis of his teams," Parac said. "Hartnell's non-scholarship program has been successful mostly due to the teaching ability of John Larick."

Larick attended school, worked and participated in rodeo in and around the state of Montana since his pre-teen years. He is a veteran of Montana amateur and pro rodeo competition. His experience in the ranch and feedlot management circles led him to California in 1971 where he began to build the Hartnell program.

Larick's collegiate rodeo teams have been a regional power for the last five years, winning the West Coast Region men's title from 1978-82. His 1982 Hartnell team finished third at the recent College National Finals Rodeo held in MSU's Brick Breeden Fieldhouse. Larick has been active in the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association, serving on the Board of Directors for the last four years.

"I've wanted to live in Bozeman since my high school days," Larick said. "This is my kind of country and my kind of people. The Hartnell rodeo program is real solid right now, and my family and I feel that the MSU job is a great opportunity. We can come to Bozeman knowing that we haven't left a dying program in California.

Larick is married to the former Patricia Friesen and they are the parents of three children, Marci 14, Daniel 13, and Jesse 6.

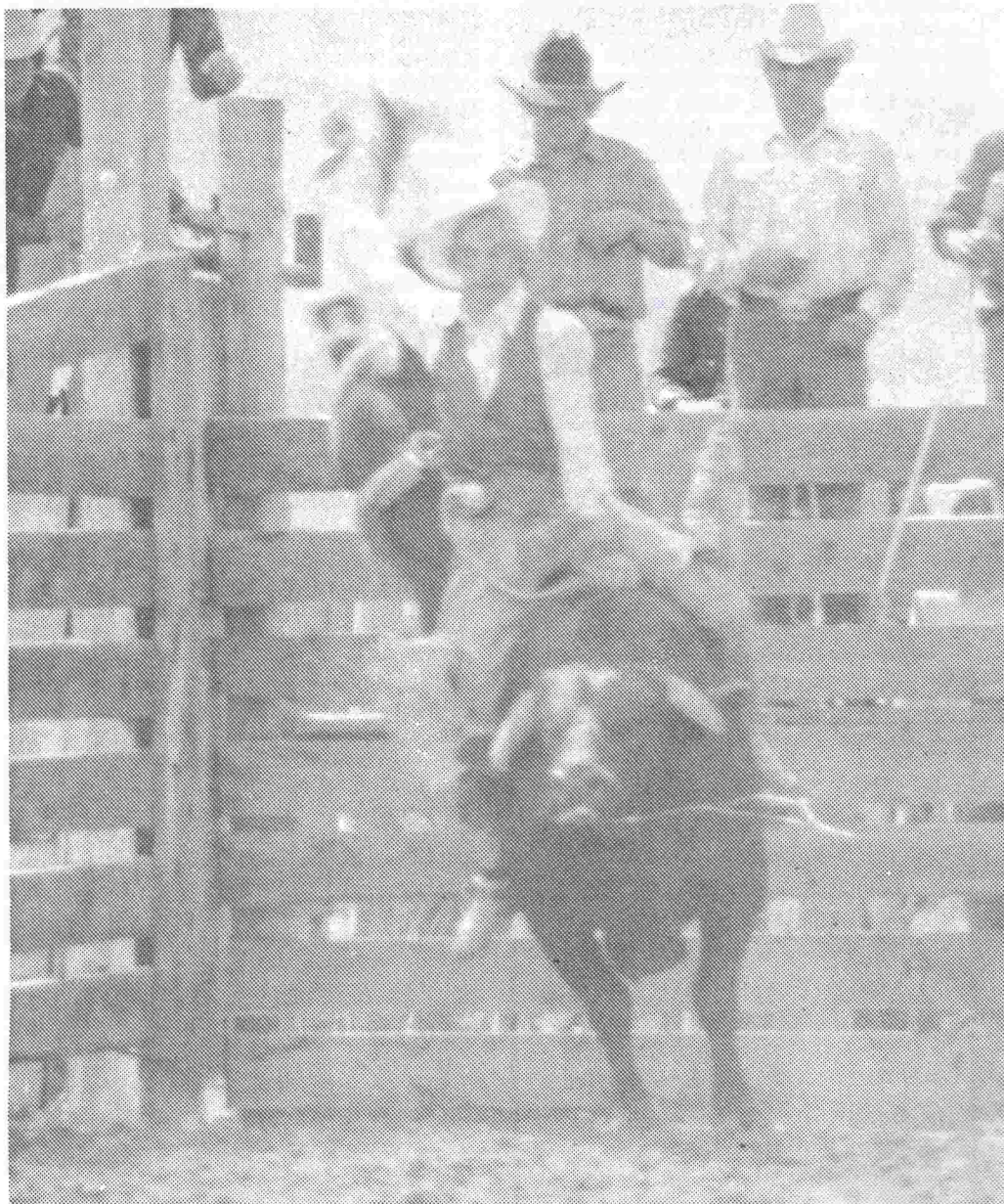
His appointment is subject to approval by the University System Board of Regents.

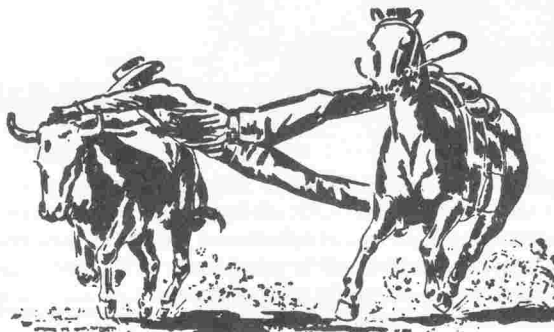

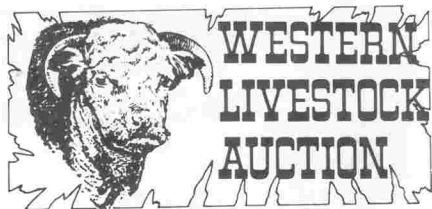

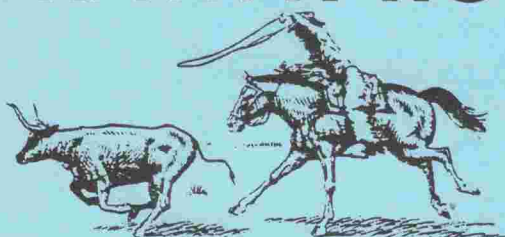
