

1980 TEAM ROPING CHAMPIONS

This abbreviated newsletter isn't much of a kick-off to the 1981 rodeo season, but it's the best we could muster with not much going on and with a decided lack of input. Here are a few items of importance:

All slack at Harlowton is July 2 at 1 p.m. Slack at Roundup is 9 a.m. on July 4.

The Calgary Stampede is July 3-12. Montana is tentatively scheduled to be up July 3 the first time. The Montana team will be selected by the NRA and MRA presidents, Ed Waldhauser and Kent Mosher. The daily payoff will be \$1717.50 per event. Seven NARC teams will participate: Australia, Alberta, British Columbia, Saskatchewan, Badlands, Northwest and Montana (MRA-NRA). Each team will have two matches, and four will go to the semi-finals. Championship match will be on July 12.

Gillette rodeo is run with IRA rules. Therefore, according to Secretary Nelda Byrne, lady competitors must wear dress pants.
