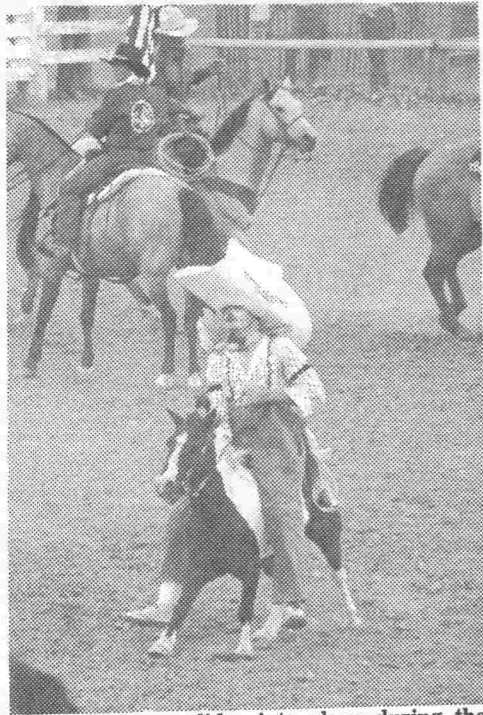

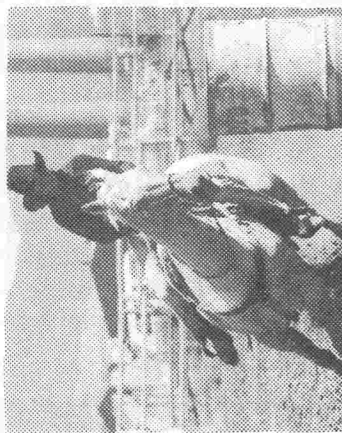

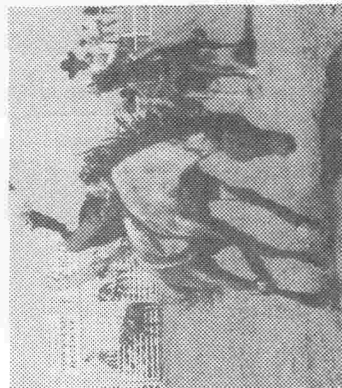

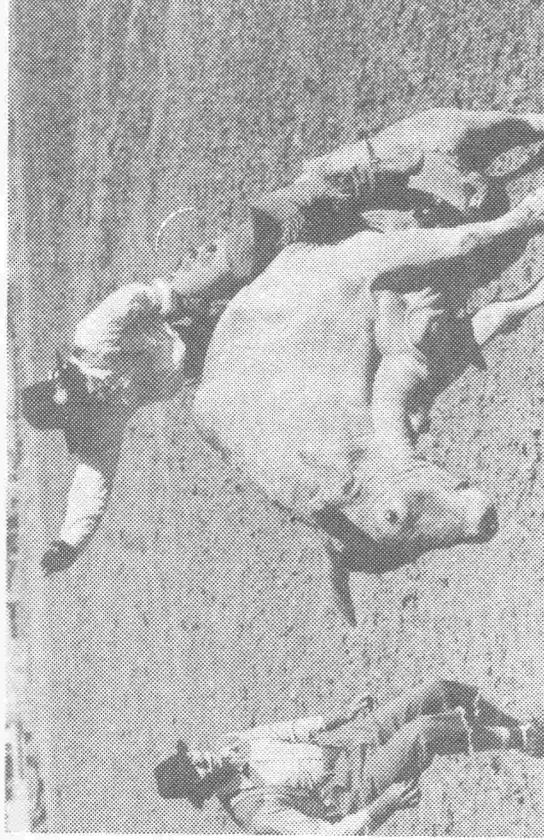

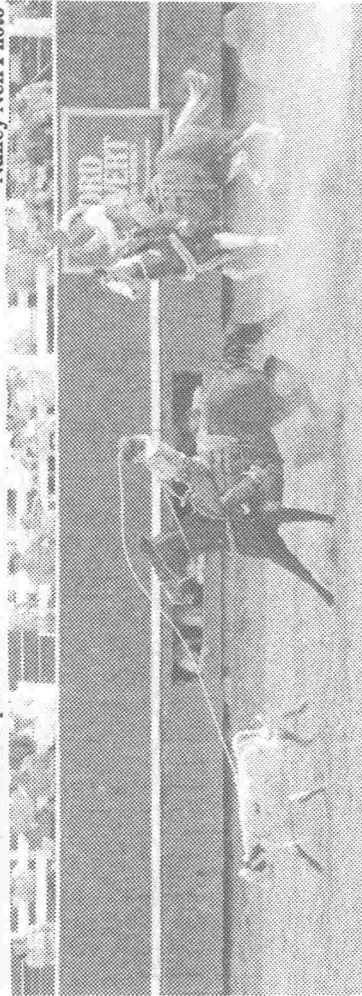

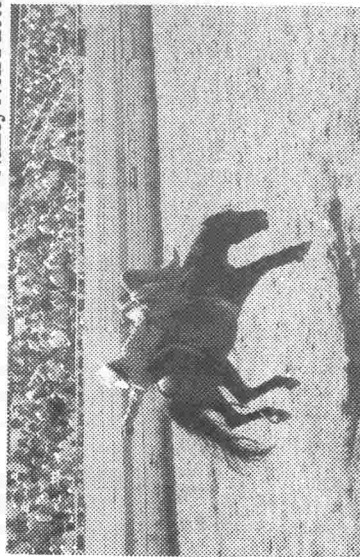

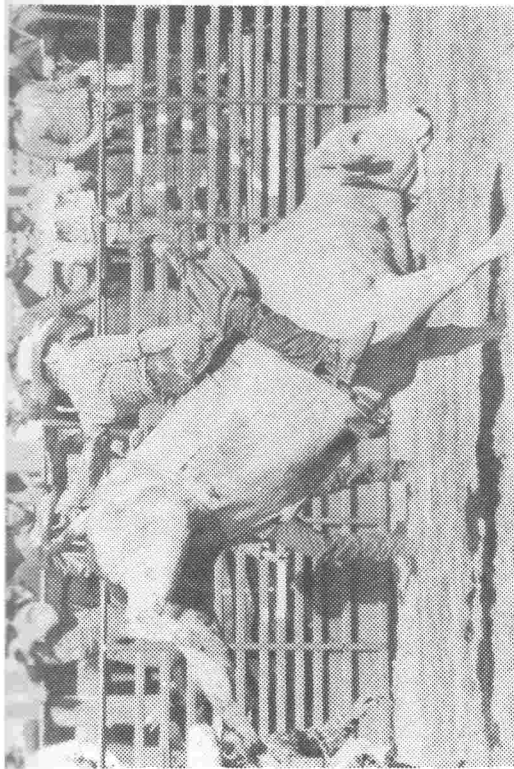

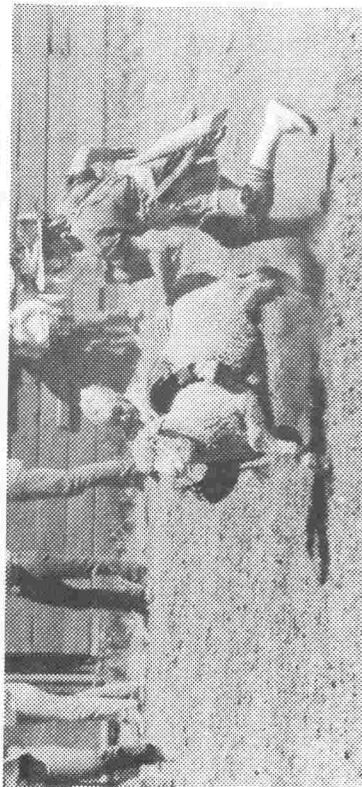

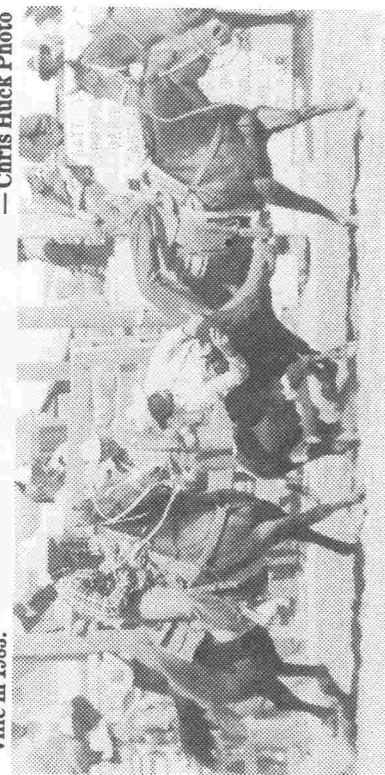
Jim Leatherberry scores a 72 on Sugar Plum last year at White Sulphur Springs. — Chris Huck Photo

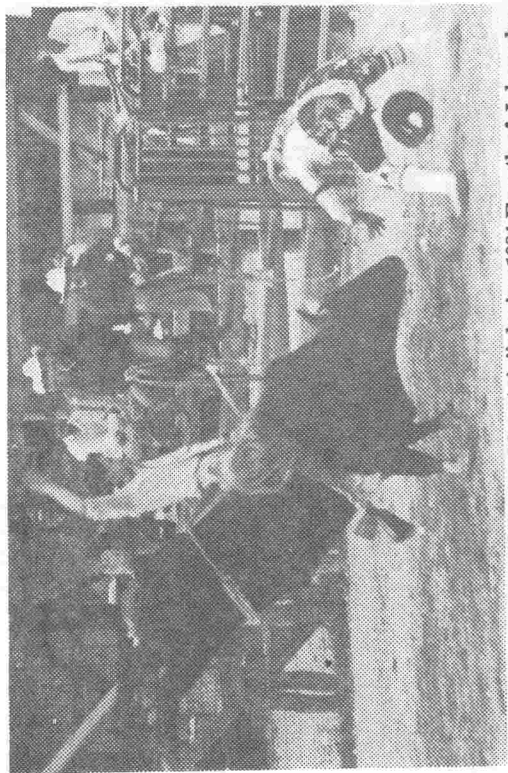

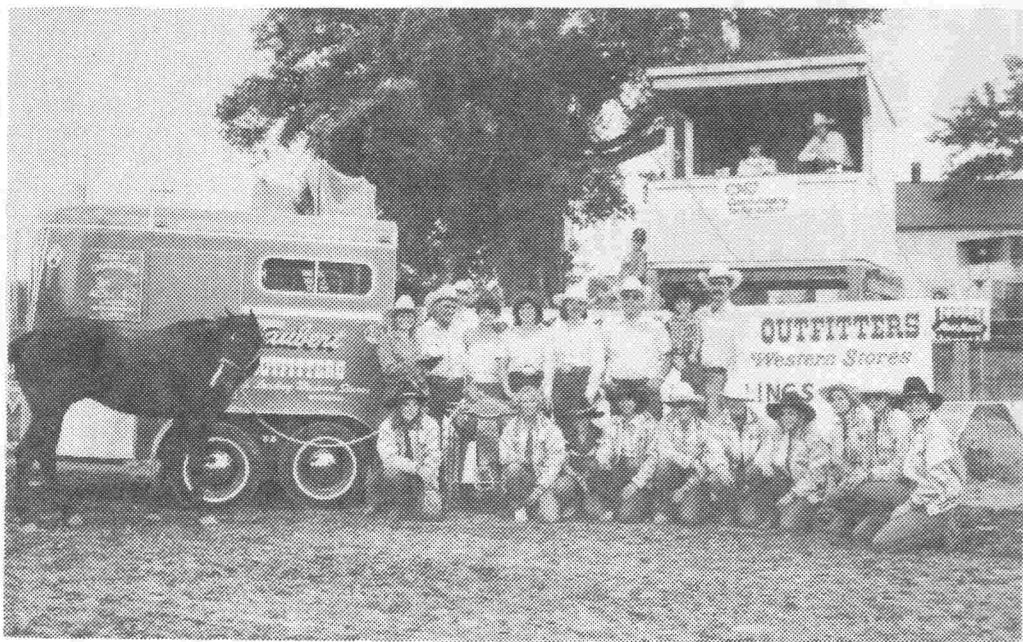

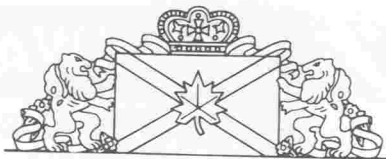

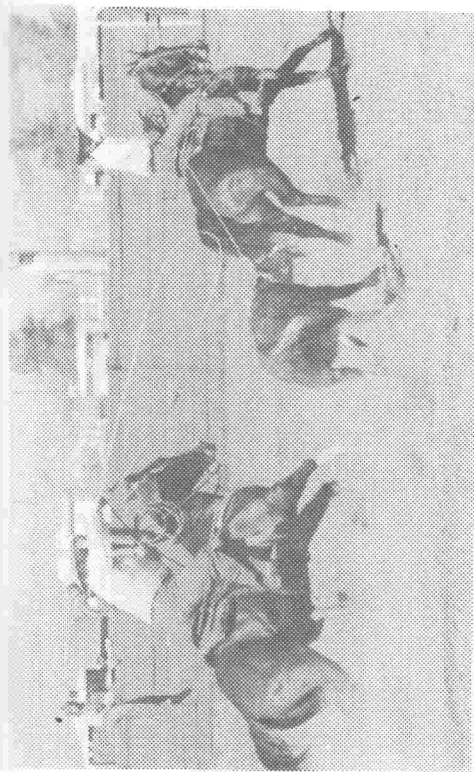

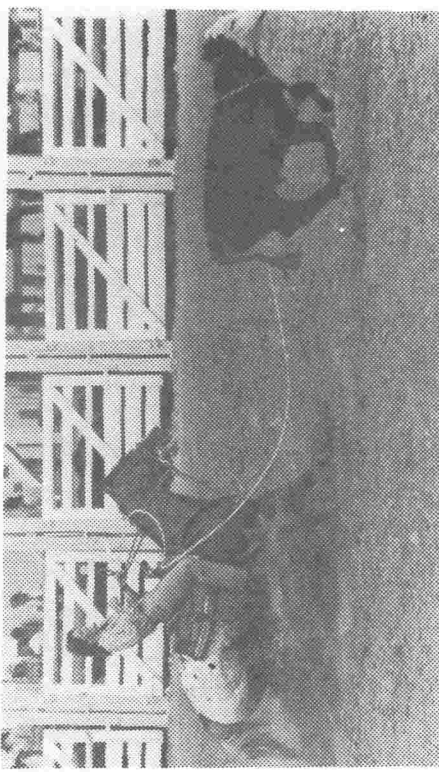

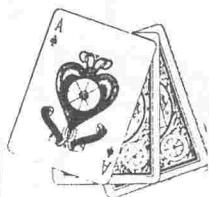

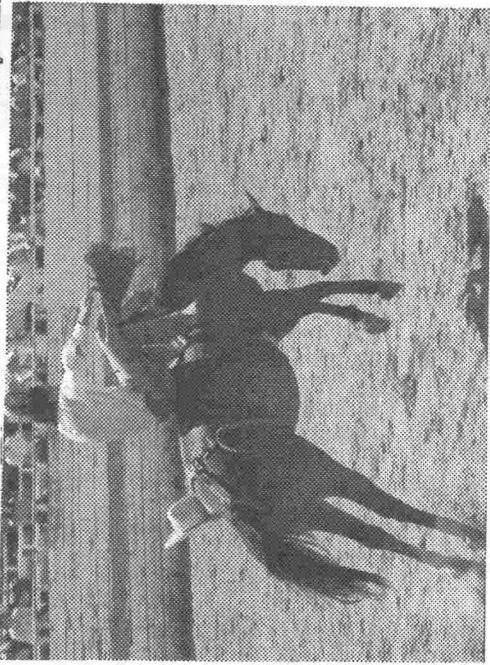

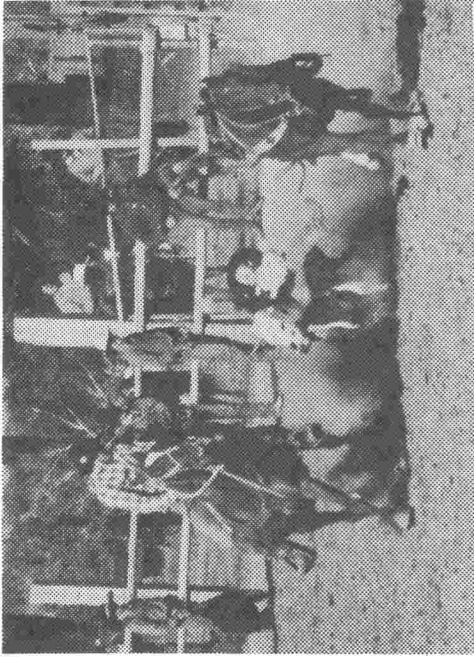

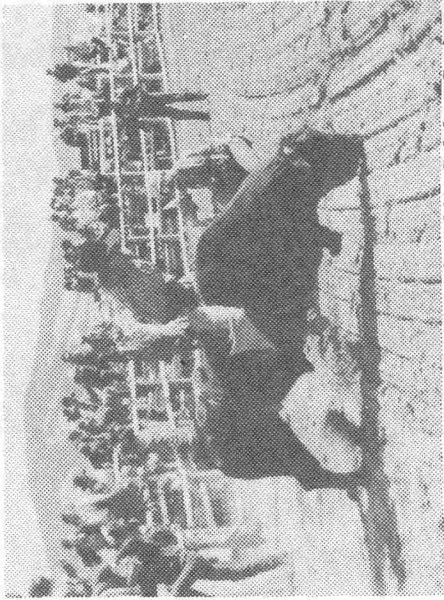

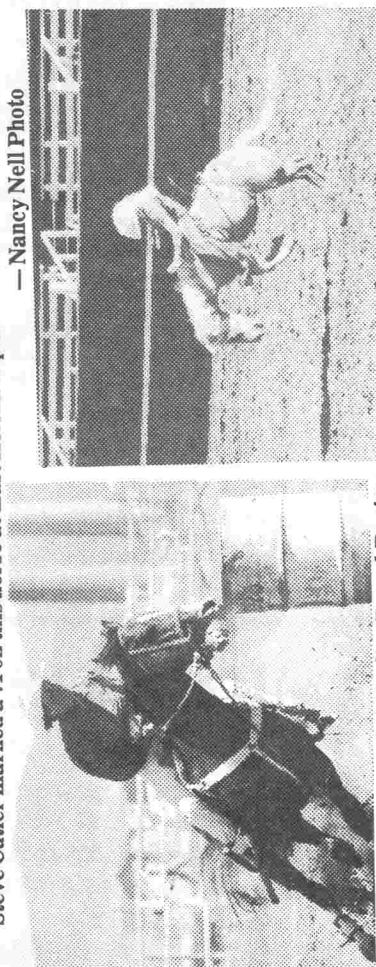
