



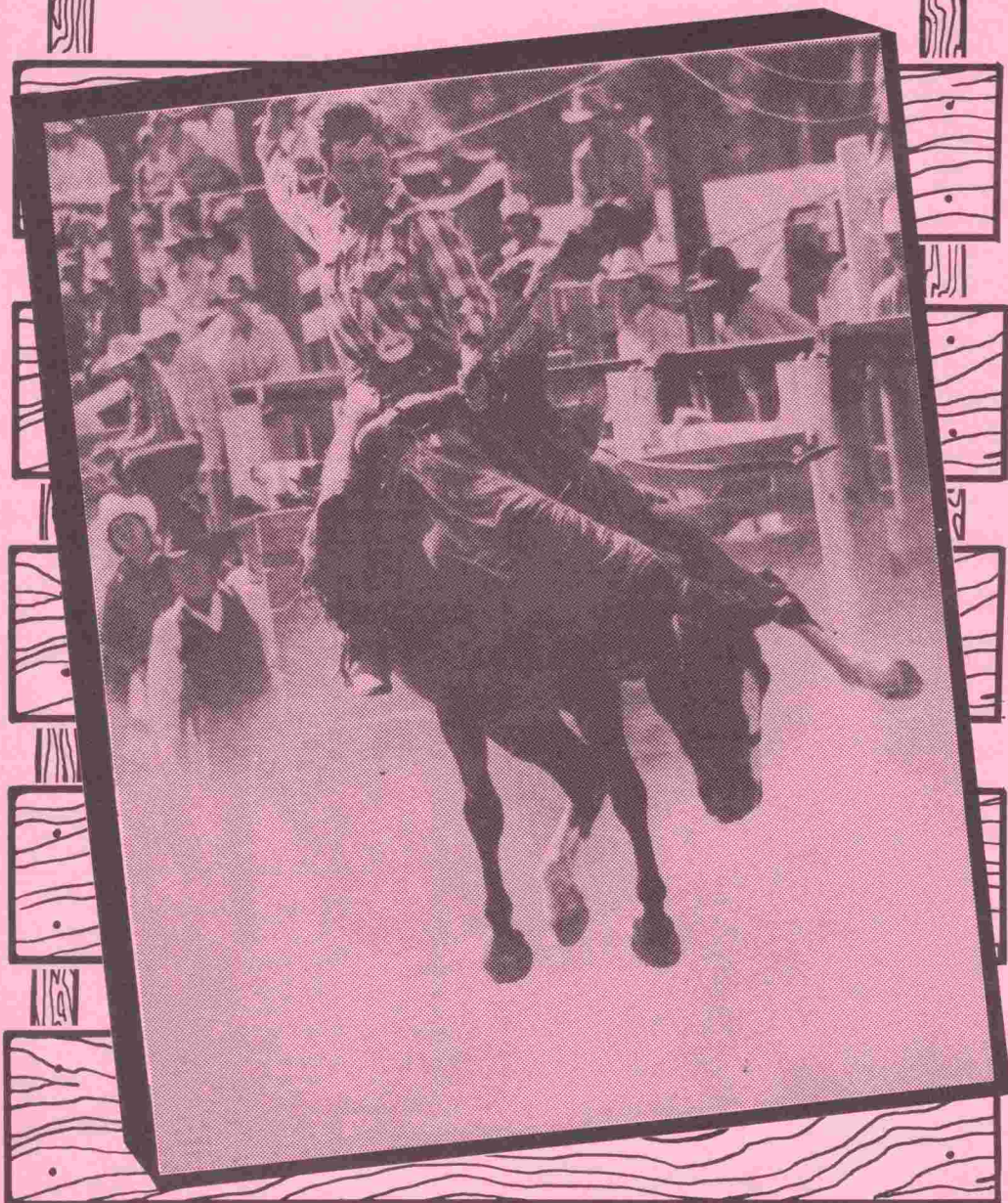

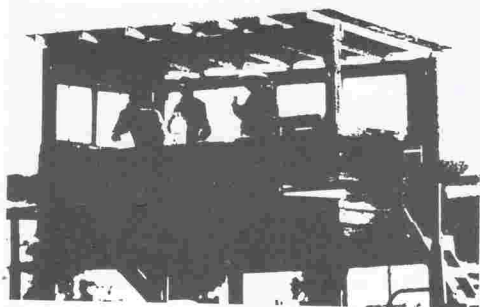

Hill Photo BAR Slated For Aug. 21

The second annual Hill Photo Breakaway Roping has been set for Sunday, Aug. 21 at the Davis Creek Sales Arena 10 miles north of Geyser, Montana.

Mary Hill reports that all is ready to go with sponsorships from Coors and from many of the Geyser area businesses. Entries must be paid by Aug. 15.

Events to be held include:

An Open-B.R.A. Approved Breakaway Roping with \$500 added and a \$55 entry fee (\$5 of this is stock charge). Each roper will get two head and the top ten get a third calf.

A Novice Horse Breakaway Roping for horses which have won less than \$100. The \$25 entry fee will be jackpotted.

A Novice Roper Breakaway Roping for ropers who have won less than \$100. The \$25 entry fee will be jackpotted.

All Girl Team Roping, \$45 entry fee per team, jackpot, enter as many times as you want.

Open-M.B.R.A. approved Barrel Race, \$100 added, \$30 entry fee, one run, championship buckle to winner.

Novice Horse Barrel Race, \$25 entry fee, jackpotted, one run.

Cowgirl auction will be held at noon at the arena.

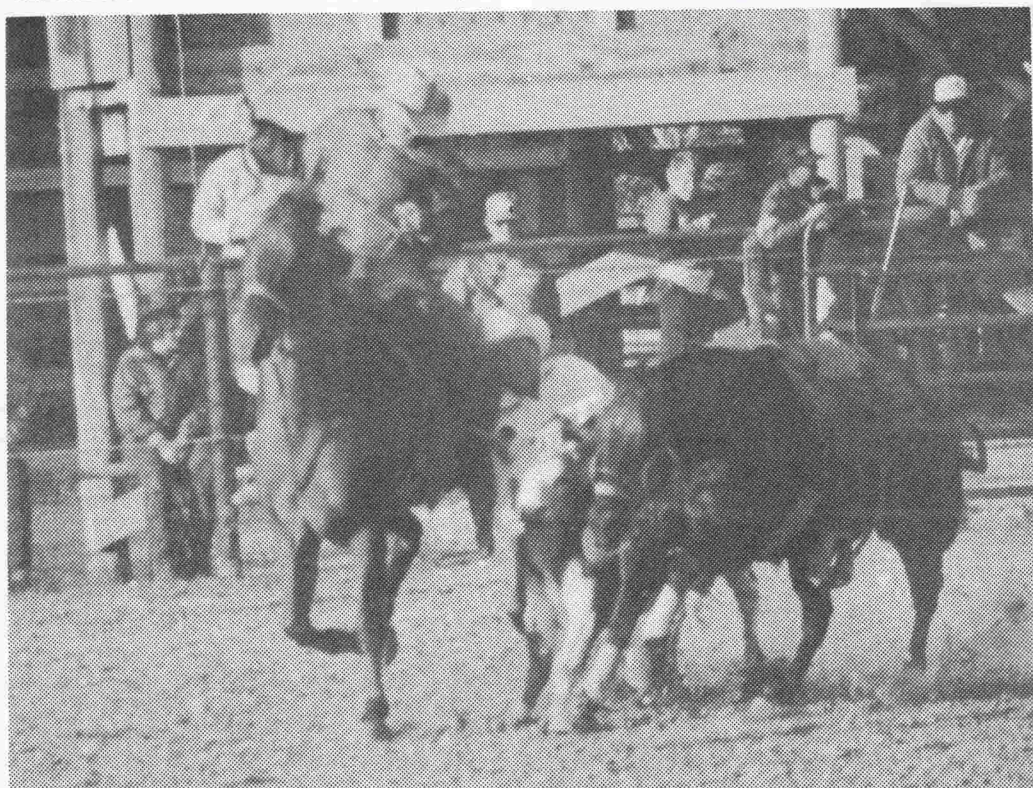

Jottings From Jann

Reports from the rodeo secretaries concerning cowboys' card numbers upon entering a rodeo are "better." Please keep it up. It really helps them out.

So far this year, including the Fourth of July rodeos, NRA/MRA rodeos have paid out over \$200,000.

I have had some complaints on contestants not paying their fees — everything from not paying them at all, to paying them when the rodeo is over. At one of the Fourth of July rodeos, 27 contestants had not paid their fees when the secretary was **trying** to pay off the rodeo. Makes it rather difficult for the secretary to get the checks written for the waiting cowboys and cowgirls when 27 people are attempting to pay their fees at the same time. Once again, use some consideration and read your rule book. She knows you are trying to get to a lot of rodeos, but those of you who have been at the rodeo one or two days have no excuse.

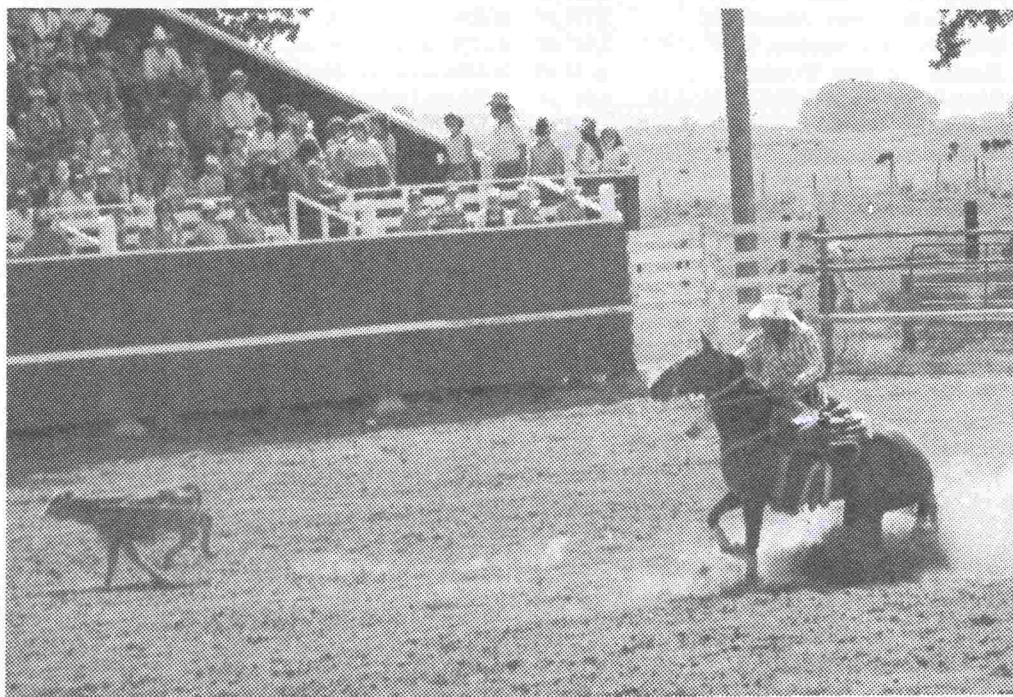
Looks as though the following bears repeating: Entry times and call back times are **ONLY** those times listed in the newsletter, not two or three days later. Take care of your business.

The year-end buckles have arrived from Kenny Hanson. Now, it is up to the directors to find sponsors to donate them.

Another problem we are having is with the local entries. To avoid turn-outs, non-payment of entry fees, and all of the other related problems, please refer to the rule book, pages 17 and 18: "Every member contestant must give his association number when entering a rodeo and is responsible for all non-member contestants entered by him. All non-members entering an association rodeo will be drawn out if entries are not paid or guaranteed by a member in good standing when entries close. The secretary is responsible for those non-member entries not drawn out when entries close." In other words, those entry fees are to be paid or guaranteed before the end of call backs, or they are to be drawn out of the rodeo.

There will be a board of directors meeting held on Aug. 17 at 9 a.m. at the Secretary's trailer on the grounds of the Yellowstone Exhibition.

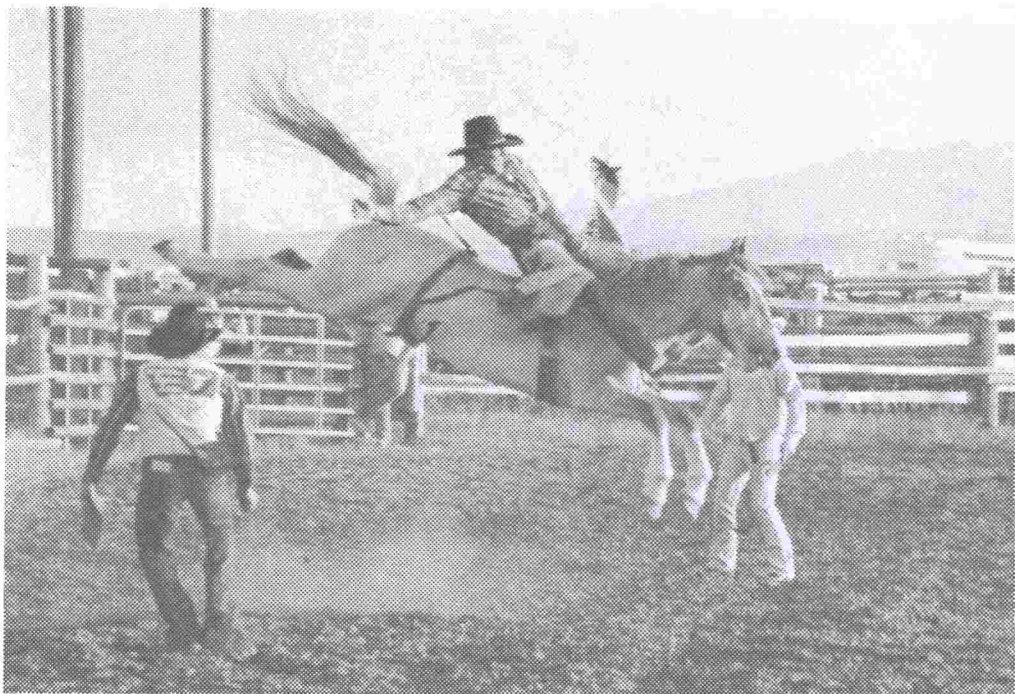

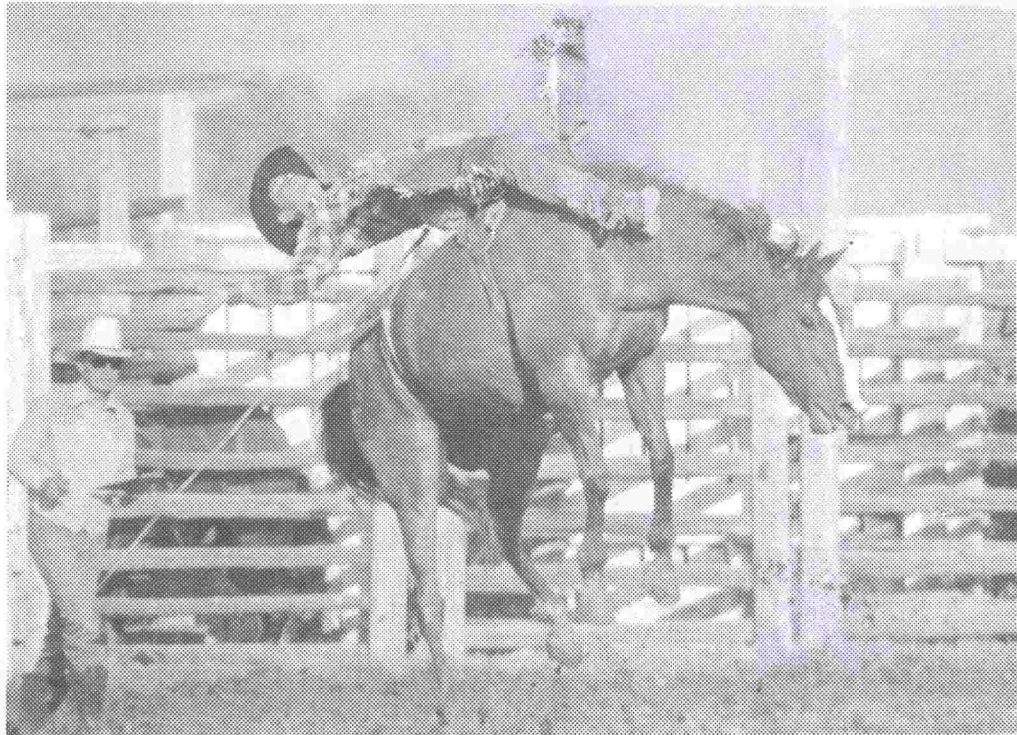

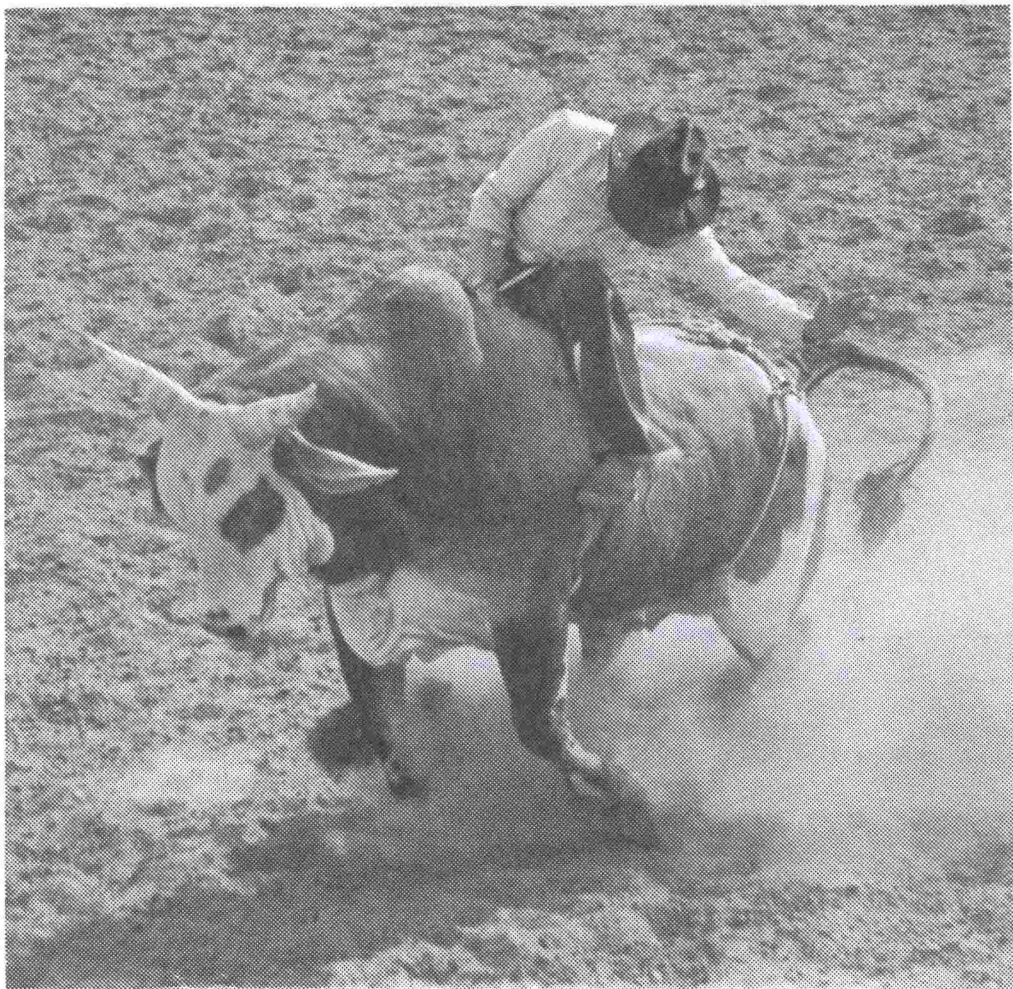

Edee Cowart — World Champion Roper

Two beautiful days of roping weather again graced the Up Front Arena at Columbus for the third annual Lou Taubert World Championship Ladies' Breakaway Roping. It was a tremendous success from the start, with Miss Rodeo America, Brenda Lee Bonogofshy, helping promote the event, to the finish, with the crowning of Edee Cowart as the World Champion Breakaway Roper.

The event began at 10 a.m. on Monday, June 27 with the open WPRA/MBRA/TBRA approved barrel race. Michelle Werre, a young high school cowgirl from Terry, surprised a few people with her excellent run of 17.61, which earned her the championship buckle as well as \$712.37 in prize money.

Following a break a noon the Watusi Grand Entry was held. Willard Moore's Watusi bull, "Breakaway," was featured, along with his girl friends, three half-blood Watusi yearling heifers and ten half blood calves. Jayne Gentry, the National College Champion Breakaway Roper, carried the American flag, while Peggy Collins, 1982 NRA Champion Breakaway Roper, carried the Montana flag, as announcer Stan Rasmussen opened the breakaway roping with introductions and the national anthem.

Edee Cowart roped tough all the way through, placing fourth in the first go-around, first in the short go, and first in the average,

with a time of 15.83 on four calves, to become the 1983 World Champion Breakaway Roper. She also garnered second place in the barrel race, winning \$563.96 to add to her winnings of \$2,702.48 in the breakaway roping. Some of her other prizes included the trophy saddle, buckle, a hat, boots, and a Coors jacket. Edee has come from Texas for the roping every year and said she'd sure be back next year. Her trip was well worth the effort as she went back home with close to \$6,000 in cash and prizes.

Montana's own World Champion Auctioneer, Bud Knight, was on hand to introduce the top 25 breakaway ropers. Some of Montana's own were included in this line-up. They were Lynn Howell of Powderville, who placed third in the average, and Staci Warburton from Missoula, who placed seventh in the average.

Willard Moore, BRA president and producer hopes to have a bigger and better roping next year. Approximately \$23,500 was given away in money and prizes this year, and Willard extends his thanks to all the sponsors and promoters of the roping, and to all those who helped. A special thanks goes to Lou Taubert Ranch Outfitters of Billings and Casper, Wyo., and the Montana Coors Distributors, as well as the Columbus businesses. Tentative dates for next year's roping are June 24 and 25, again following the College National Finals Rodeo.

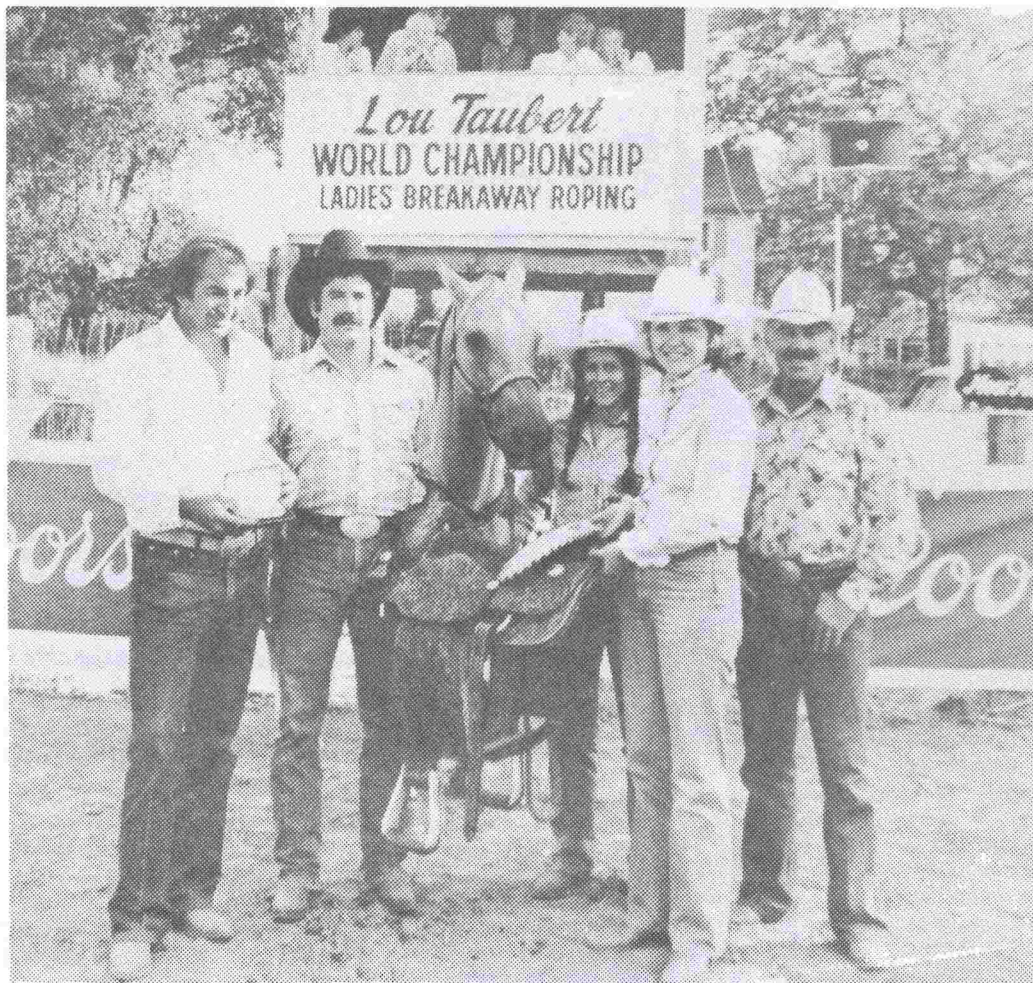

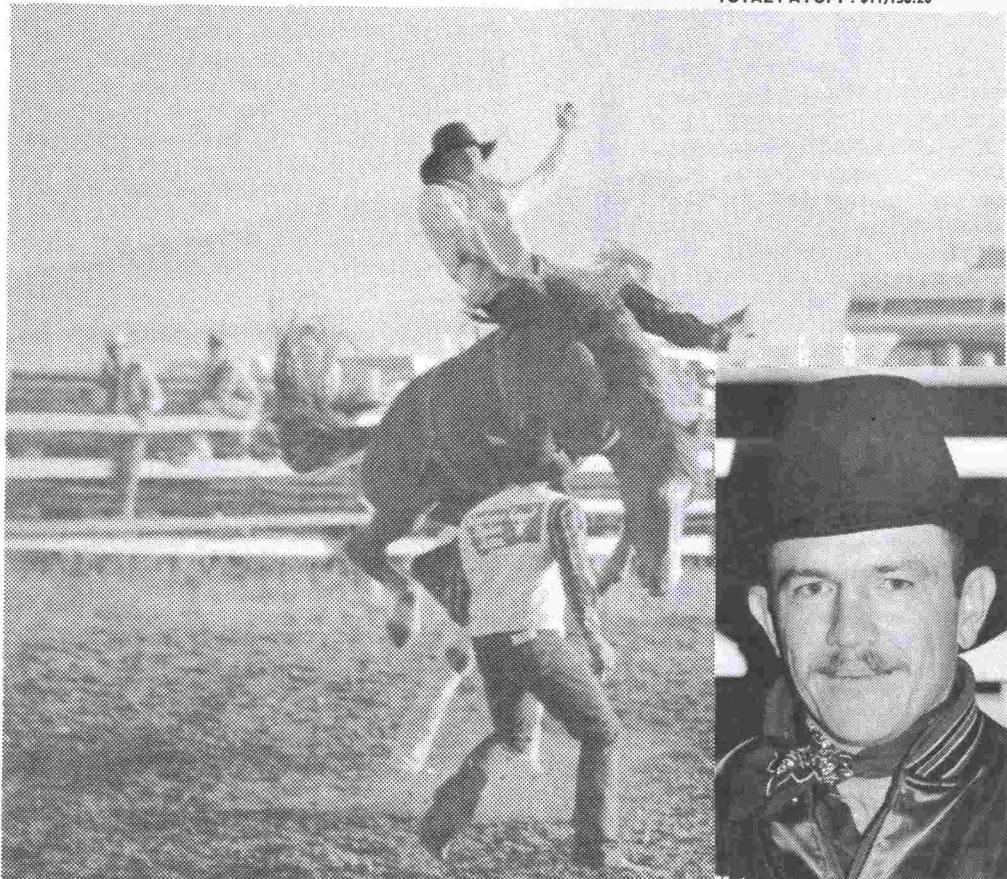

Rule Changes

Please make note of these rule changes for the 1983 rodeo season.

A sponsoring rodeo committee is a member of the NRA/MRA with one vote per committee at the general membership meeting.

Payoff is to be followed exactly as stated in the rule book, regardless of circumstances. Example: Two contestants entered in an event. Both place in that event. First place to receive 40%, second place to receive 30%, the remaining 20% and 10% of payoff will be ground split between the two contestants.

If contestant's fees are paid but the contestant turns out, the money is figured into the payoff for that event.

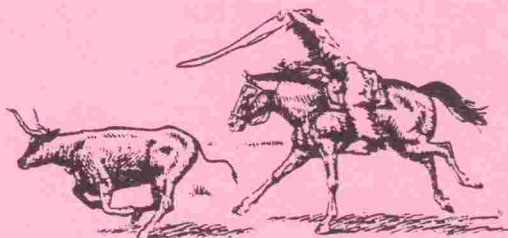
Team roping payoff example: 21 teams x \$80 entry fee (\$4; per man) = \$1680 - 3% (\$50.40) = \$1629.60 ÷ 2 = \$814.80. There will be five (5) places paid in the team roping event.

Dues will be \$60 until April 1, instead of March 15, as previously announced.
